Rules for Display of Projects on Thursday 11th March 2010

1. Each project will have 2 tables of desk space for computers, peripherals etc. Tables 2 x 4 ft.
2. Each project will have access to 2 electrical points. If you require more then you should bring a multi-plug.
3. Each project will be permitted to have a maximum of 6 students and 3 teachers. Other pupils, parents and others will be welcome from 4.30pm
4. If you wish to have a vertical display you need to bring display boards. No display will be permitted on the walls.
5. The Education Centre will be available for schools to set-up projects during the day of Thursday 11th. Schools are requested to have projects set-up for 4pm at the latest.
6. The public will be admitted from 4.30pm.
7. Judging will commence at 4.30pm sharp. Pupils will be invited to present their project to adjudicators for not more than 7 minutes. Pupils should be made aware that they may be visited by a second team of adjudicators.
8. While the judges are present each project team should have representatives (especially pupils) at its own project. 99
- . 9. Awards will be presented at 6.30pm and the event will be complete by 7pm.
10. Schools are requested to take all material with them at the end of the evening.
